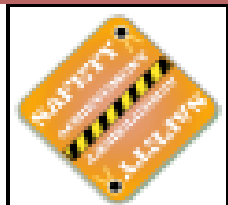

## Being up to date pays off

Between February 1st and April 30th all companies must post the summary of work-related injuries and illnesses, the OSHA's Form 300A. On this form will be the total amount of recordable employee injuries and illnesses that had happen during 2008.

In order to do this properly you need to previously fill out the OSHA's form 300, or Log of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses. In this log you must record all the information about every work-related injury, illness that involves loss of consciousness, restricted work or job transfer, days away from work or medical treatment beyond first

aid.

If you were keeping your records up to date in the OSHA Log, not only you are avoiding the \$275 fine, also it helps you to fill out the OSHA's 300A form.

Otherwise you will have a hard time gathering all the last year information. The good side of this tedious task: the forms come in a self explanatory booklet that includes the entire guide needed in how to fill it out.

Also this kind of record can show us a great deal of information: like accident tendencies and recurrences, high points and lows, and can show us a path in how to prevent futures accidents. Or how to wisely implement a modify work plan.

## Avoiding fines and higher Workers Compensation costs

- Check all your OSHA log and first aid records for the

last 3+ years to find out how many accidents (in percentage) have happen on your employees face area, also check

machinery/task face protection requirements.

## Avoiding fines and higher WC costs *(cont.)*

- Provide eye/face protection accordingly with the task to be done (read labels, manuals and use your common sense too!) **included!!!)**
- All eye protection provided must meet ANSI standards.
- Post warning signs and enforce the rules (*supervisors* **Do not speculate: Eye**
- Apply the PPE "take care of pay for it" rule.
- Remember sun glasses, reading glasses or any other prescript kind of eye glasses are **NOT safety glasses** and can lead in to a serious injury!

## Got Forklift Certification?
